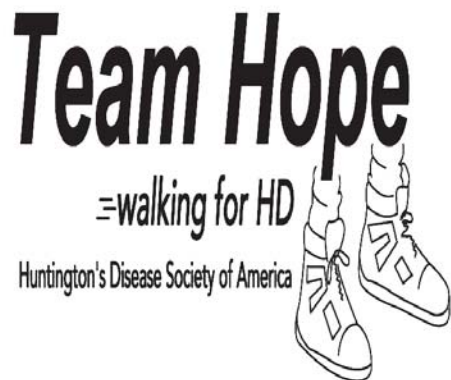

Huntington's Disease Society of America

What is Huntington's Disease (HD)?

Huntington's Disease is a hereditary brain disorder that slowly robs the affected individual of the ability to work, talk, and reason. There are over 30,000 people in the United States currently diagnosed with HD and each of their siblings and children have a 50% chance of developing this HD. HD is a "family disease", not just because it is inherited, but because it profoundly affects the entire family emotionally, socially and financially. An estimated 50,000 Texans are affected by HD. HD touches the lives of over one million people in the United States.

Currently, there is no effective treatment or cure for HD.

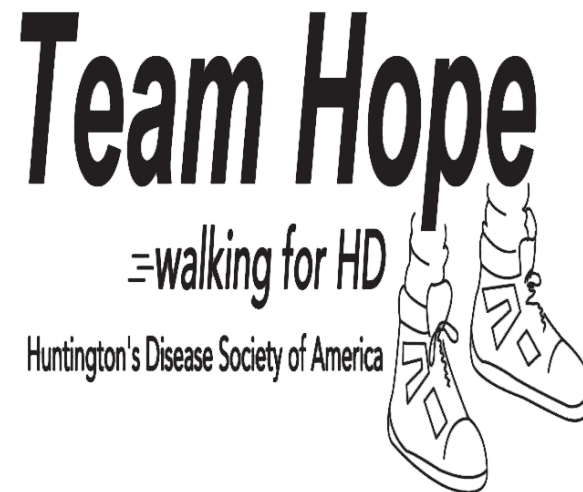
STEP 2: Raise money!
